**Public Service Announcement to Flush Water Lines**


It is always a good practice to flush all water supply lines to ensure fresh water is in the facility's system after a closure.

While restaurants, gyms, schools and other buildings are closed to prevent the spread of COVID-19, water left sitting in pipes could change in quality during a prolonged shutdown.

When buildings are able to reopen be sure to flush cold water lines to waste until water temperature changes. It may also be necessary to have a plumber flush hot water systems.
